CAMP COACHES



Matt Houk
Head Coach

The 2011 campaign will be the fourth season for Matt Houk as the head volleyball coach at South Dakota. Houk has compiled a record of 50-40 during his first three seasons as the Coyote mentor. Houk is already third in career wins at South Dakota with 50, and has the best winning percentage of any coach in school history (.556).

The 2010 Coyotes faced another difficult schedule, which included facing six schools in the top 100 of the NCAA RPI. After a slow start to the season, the Coyotes found their form midway through the year and finished 12-4 over their final 16 matches, including a big road win over in-state rival South Dakota State. Senior Kristin Krittenbrink earned first-team All-Great West honors, becoming the first Coyote to earn first-team honors at the Division I level. In addition, junior Carol Logato and sophomore Kim Bulaga earned all-conference second team honors, while Logato and Natalie Walseth were named to the all-newcomer team. The Coyotes earned six GWC Player of the Week honors in 2010 as well.

South Dakota advanced to the Great West Conference Championship game for the first time ever, losing to North Dakota. Senior Kristin Krittenbrink and freshman Natalie Walseth both earned all-tournament honors. The Coyotes finished 8-4 in conference play as well.



Leanne Felsing
Assistant Coach

Leanne Felsing will enter her third season as an assistant coach with The University of South Dakota Coyotes in 2011. Felsing comes to USD after a decorated playing career at the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee from 2004-07. Felsing put together one of the best

all-around seasons in UWM history in 2007, leading the nation in triple-doubles while earning AVCA All-Region and honorable mention All-America honors for a second-straight season. Felsing finished her career with 1,146 kills, 1,329 digs and 2,264 assists helping the Panthers to four regular season league titles. She was a two-time national player of the week honoree and, earlier in her career, claimed League Newcomer of the Year recognition. Felsing excelled in the classroom throughout her career, collecting academic all-league and all-region recognition. Felsing was also named the Horizon League Player of the Year, an All-Horizon League honoree, ESPN The Magazine Academic All-District selection and Horizon League All-Academic Team.
